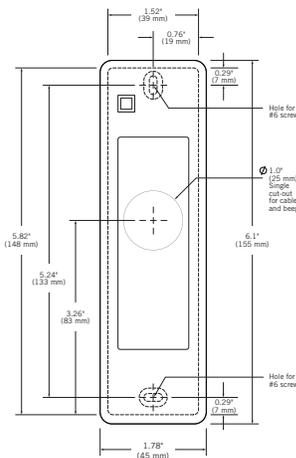


## Global Access
